

GOVERNANCE

In a Multi-Academy Trust (MAT), the Trust is responsible for all of its schools/academies. For the Community Inclusive Trust, governance of our MAT resides with Members, Trustees and Local School Boards.



MEMBERS

The Members are akin to the shareholders of a company. They have ultimate control over the Academy Trust.



TRUSTEES

The Trustees are responsible for the three core areas of governance:

- Ensuring clarity of vision, ethos and strategic direction.
- Holding executive leaders to account for the educational performance of the organisation and its pupils, and the effective and efficient performance management of staff; and
- Overseeing the financial performance of the organisation and making sure its money is well spent.



LOCAL SCHOOL BOARDS AND LOCAL GOVERNORS

CIT Schools have a committed team of Governors who are actively involved in the life of the school. They reflect the community they serve and include parent, community and staff representatives. The Strategic Lead for Trust Development & Governance, along with the Company Secretary, provide advice and guidance to our Local School Boards ensuring they are well-equipped to support and challenge their schools.
